

# Unit 1: Heian/Kamakura/Nanboku-chō period [Contents]

#### Heian/Kamakura period

Ribuōki [吏部王記] Diary of Emperor Daigo's fourth son, Imperial Prince Shigeakira (重明親王: 906-954). The diary is important historical material for studying the political affairs and the Imperial Council of the Heian period. [Recording period]:921(延喜 20 年)-953(天暦 7 年)

Gonki〔権記〕 3 vol.

Diary of Fujiwara no Yukinari (藤原行成: 972-1027), also known as Fujiwara no Kōzei, a Japanese official and calligrapher. Contains a wealth of important information about politics and court life under Fujiwara rule. [Recording period]: 991 (正暦 2 年) -1010 (寛弘 7 年)

Taiki 〔台記〕 [1 vol.]

Diary of Fujiwara no Yorinaga (藤原頼長: 1120-56), who was from the Fujiwara clan in the post of imperial regent and was the Minister of the Left. He is also known for masterminding the Hogen Disturbance. [Recording period]: 1136(保延2年)-1143(康治2年)

Meigetsuki (明月記) [1 vol.]

Diary of the courtier and noted poet Fujiwara no Teika (藤原定家: 1162-1241), one of the 21 imperial anthologies of classical Japanese poetry (waka). [Recording period]: 1180 (治承4年) -1197 (建久8年), including Meigetsuki Catalog

2 vols.

Yōkōki [葉黄記] Diary of Hamuro Sadatsugu (葉室定嗣: 1208-72), a Jpanese official given an important position by Retired Emperor Gosaga. Valuable as records of Insei (院政; politics by the retired emperor). [Recording period]: 1230 (寛喜 2 年) -1249 (宝治 3 年)

Kanchūki [勘仲記] Diary of Kadenokōji Fujiwara no Kanenaka (勘解由小路藤原兼仲: 1244-1308), a courtier and archivist. Indispensable for studying the political history of Japan in the latter half of the 13th century. [Recording period]: 1274 (文永 11 年) -1288 (正応元年)

Kinhira-kōki 〔公衡公記〕 [4 vols.]

Diary of Saionji Kinhira (西園寺公衡: 1264-1315), who was promoted to the Minister of the Left and served as a liaison between the imperial court and the shogunate. [Recording period]:1283(弘安 6 年)-1315(正和 4 年)

Hanazono-Tennō-shinki 〔花園天皇宸記〕【3 vols.】 Diary of Emperor Hanazono (花園天皇:1297-1348). These writings are important for studying the culture and the circumstances of succession to the throne at the end of the Kamakura period. [Recording period]: 1310 (延慶3年) -1332 (正慶元年)

#### Nanboku-chō period

Entairyaku〔園太暦〕 [7 vols.]

Diary of Tōin Kinkata (洞院公賢: 1291-1360), a grand minister of state (dajō daijin). A great resource for learning about the Nanbokuchō period, when two rival courts existed. [Recording period]: 1311 (応長元年) -1360 (延文5年)

Moromoriki〔師守記〕 [11 vols.]

Diary of the 14th-century courtier, Nakahara Moromori (中原師守). The diary is valuable because it contains not only the records of that time but also many precedents. [Recording period]:1339(曆応 2 年)-1374(応安 7 年)

Kōyōki〔迎陽記〕 2 vols.

Diary of Higashibōjō Hidenaga (東坊城秀長: 1338-1411), a scholar who served Emperor Go-En'yu and Emperor Gokomatsu of the Northern Court. First-class materials for studying the politics and arts of the time. [Recording period]: 1379(康曆元年)-1401(応永 8 年)

〔兼宣公記〕【2 vols.】

Diary of Hirohashi Kanenobu (広橋兼宣: 1366-1429), an official who was the liaison between the imperial court and the shogunate in the days of the third and fourth shogun of the Muromachi Shogunate. [Recording period]: 1387 (至徳 4 年) -1424 (応永 31 年)
